JUNE 2009 MONTHLY REPORT

The month of June included 2540 service calls. The most frequent calls are for service are building checks (721), motor vehicle stops (488), ambulance calls (130) and alarms (85).

During June, officers investigated and reported on several incidents. Some of the incidents that were investigated are called index crimes.

Index crimes include murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny and motor vehicle theft. Arson also is included, but is not considered an index crime.

Most crashes occurred on Monday (11) & Friday (9). The location where most crashes occurred was at the intersection of the Berlin Turnpike at Ramp C (3). There were (9) crashes on the Berlin Turnpike, followed by (7) on Route 372, and (4) on the New Britain Road. The top three causative crash factors were Following too close (23), Failure to Grant the right of Way (4), and Failure to drive in the established lane (3). There were (2) DUI related crashes last month.

33% of all crashes (16) were cleared with an Infractions / Summons. Written warnings were issued twelve (12) times (25%), verbal warnings seven (7) times (16%), no enforcement nine (9) times (19%), and four cases are pending (8%).
