FEBRUARY 2010 MONTHLY REPORT

The month of February included 2239 service calls. The most frequent calls for service are building checks (753), motor vehicle stops (478), ambulance calls (138) and alarms (85).

During February, officers investigated and reported on several incidents. Some of the incidents that were investigated are called index crimes.

Index crimes include murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny and motor vehicle theft. Arson also is included, but is not considered an index crime.

Motor Vehicle Accidents

Most crashes occurred on Tuesday (12) and Friday (10). The intersections that had the most crashes in February were the Berlin Turnpike at Ramp C (2) and The Berlin Turnpike at Deming Road (2). The location where most crashes occurred was the Berlin Turnpike (13), followed by (7) on Chamberlain Highway, Route 372 (6), New Britain Road (2) and Christian Lane (2). The top three causative crash factors were Traveling Too Fast for Conditions (11), Following Too Closely (10), and Failure to Grant the Right of Way (4). There were (3) DUI related crashes last month.

58% of all crashes (26) were cleared with infractions or summons. Written warnings were issued eight (8) times (18%) and no enforcement five (5) times (11%). Three (3) investigations are pending (7%) and one (1) investigation is unknown (2%).
