NOVEMBER 2011 MONTHLY REPORT

The month of November included 2,319 service calls. The most frequent calls for service are building checks (587), motor vehicle stops (582), ambulance calls (71) and alarms (94).

During November, officers investigated and reported on several incidents. Some of the incidents that were investigated are called index crimes.

Index crimes include murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny and motor vehicle theft. Arson also is included, but is not considered an index crime.

Motor Vehicle Accidents

Most crashes occurred on a Tuesday (14), followed by (9) on Wednesday and Thursday. The location where most crashes occurred were on the Berlin Turnpike (17) followed by (6) on Rt. 372. The intersection with the most crashes for the month was the Berlin Turnpike at Woodlawn Road with three (3). The top causative crash factor was Following Too Closely (15). Failure to Grant ROW, Unsafe Backing and Deer strikes all had (4) each for the next most common causative factor.

51% of all crashes (21) were cleared with infractions. Written warnings were issued twelve (12) times (29%), there were no verbal warnings given and no enforcement action was given seven times (17%).
