**Berlin Police Department Invites Public Comment**

The Berlin Police Department is eligible for a direct grant of \$18,147.00 under the United States Department of Justice, 2009 Recovery Act; Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program. This funding may be used for a number of law enforcement related purposes including but not limited to technical assistance, training, equipment, contractual support and criminal justice information systems that will enhance law enforcement programs.

The goal of this program is to improve law enforcement services and help preserve and/or create jobs and thereby stimulate the economy.

The Berlin Police Department is preparing to apply for these funds to purchase portable remote video camera equipment that will be used with the Town's planned wireless data communications system. It would also be used to purchase software, hardware and technical assistance for the department's criminal justice information system, computer aided dispatch and records management systems.
